SPACING: Between plants.
MATURE: Days to maturity.

TEMP: Soil Temperature
C= Cool Crop/ Early spring planting, soil is 50-65°F
W= Warm Crop/After last frost planting, soil is 65-85°F

Soil Preparation

Prepare vegetable beds by spading deeply. Have your soil tested to determine appropriate amendments. For existing beds add about 2 inches of compost and turn the soil over again. Then rake it smooth and the bed will be ready for plants.

* Best Soil Contains: 10/20% Clay + 25-60% Silt + 20/50% Sand = Loam

* 1/3 of the final mix should be organic matter (peat moss, manure, bark, compost).

* Mulch: A 2-3" layer around will help prevent some weeds, also will retain moisture in the soil longer and maintain a more stable soil temperature. Straw or hay is a good choice for vegetable garden mulch.

* Soil pH affects plant metabolism. Optimum pH for vegetables is between 6.0 and 7.5.

- Lower pH by adding soil sulphur.
- Raise pH by adding lime.
- When adding lime in large amounts add in stages and cultivate into soil.
