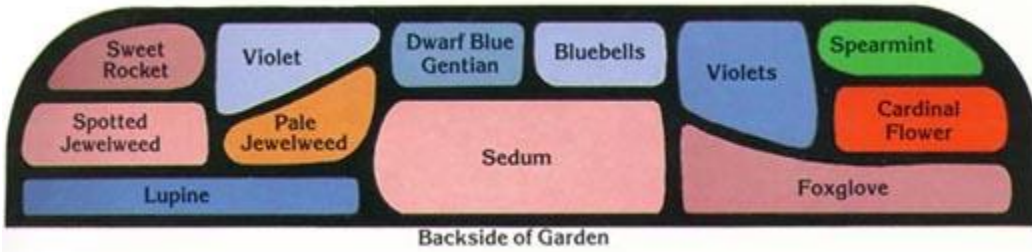
Trees and Shrubs to Encourage Native Pollinators

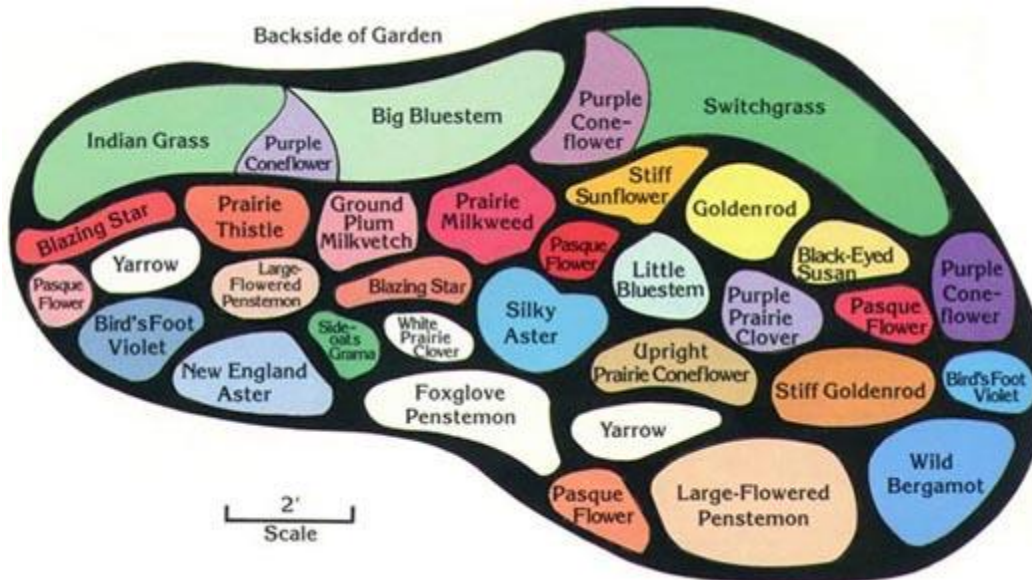
