
#### **SPRAY SCHEDULE FOR APPLES**

Apple bud stages through fruit set. Spray applications are most effective when used at appropriate dates. Local weather data and bud stage observations are helpful in determining when to spray.

<sup>\*</sup>NOTE: If you are spraying for Fire blight control, post bloom sprays (Copper sulfate and/or Streptomycin) are not effective. If fire blight symptoms are noticed, then hand pruning is required. Prune out infected portions 6-8 "below point of infection. Burn or discard infected plant parts. Disinfect tools before moving on to other parts of the canopy. (Isopropyl alcohol or 1:10 bleach solution)
